

Addendum to Contract CSGC 2018-1

The purpose of this Amendment is to include other funding sources for Internship/Work Experience programs and change or add the below listed sections.

Effective date of this addendum is 8/18/2022.

Page 1 Section 1 Terms of the Agreement

Revised to retroactively add the following additional extension options:

10/1/21-9/30/22

10/1/22-9/30/23

10/1/23-9/30/24

10/1/24-9/30/25

Page 2 Section 2.2 The following is added:

Contractor will every January and July give updated billing rates, subject to CSGC's agreement. Below are anticipated billing rates for two common positions with and without worker's comp.

Laborer (without WC)	136%	Laborer (with WC 5613)	147%
Humanitarian (without WC)	136%	Humanitarian (with WC 8810)	136%

Page 2 Section 2.5 This section is deleted. It is addressed in Section 4.7.

Page 4 Section 3.8.1.2 The following is added:

Time tracking and approvals by temp employees and supervisors will be electronic via an online cell phone app, at no cost to CSGC, temp employees, or worksites.

Page 5 Section 4 Strike the second paragraph and replace with this:

Employer of Record services are generally required under federal workforce programs or when CSGC receives limited term grand funding under federal programs. Unless otherwise amended and agreed upon by both parties all individuals hired under this agreement who are working on restoration following a disaster shall be working on public property or with non-profit organizations performing humanitarian assistance unless expressly and specifically requested by CSGC. For individuals participating in Internship/Work Experience programs workers will not be required to work at public or non-profit sector worksites but may be. They *can* be placed with for profit businesses. In either case all workers will be assigned by CSGC to identified worksite employers. CSGC may also be designated a worksite employer under certain circumstances. The assigned workers will work under the direction, control, and supervision of the worksite employer. If the contract is later amended to include other funding sources it is understood that these grants normally require a quick ramp up of personnel, particularly during an emergency, and have specific employment eligibility requirements that must be met. Individuals classified by CSGC as participants under specific grants may require the Contractor to account for them accordingly. It should also be noted that grant periods of performance are not standardized and may result in varying start and ending dates for programs during the term of a contract. In addition to Section 3, "Scope of Work- General" above, the following staffing services are required:

Page 7 Section 4.10.1.1 The toll-free number to report work related injuries or illnesses has changed to 800-455-2079 and the four-digit code "2306" should be provided to AmeriSys.

Page 8 Section 4.16 is added. A site visit and safety inspection are required for all proposed worksites.

Page 8 Section 4.17 is added. Contractor will procure and issue necessary equipment approved by CSGC and be reimbursed at cost. Examples: safety glasses, boots, tools.

Page 8 Section 4.18 is added. Worksite agreements are required and must be signed by Contactor's Area Representative. A 24-hour turn around is required for signatures.
