C. SUMMARY REPORT

1. Summary analysis of the local labor market based on the industry representative needs and education offerings. (Provide summary)

Kim Bodine provided an overview of Labor Market Information including the slight increase in unemployment over the same time last year. She highlighted Leisure & Hospitality Sector, Education and Health Services, Financial Activities, and Professional and Business Services as industries that grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year. Our metro had the fastest annual job growth rate compared to all other FL metro areas, and the second fastest job growth rate in the state in Leisure and Hospitality. She indicated that Economic Development was still moving at a brisk pace with many projects in aerospace, marine and manufacturing.

2. Information on priority industry sectors and occupations for the local area. (Provide summary)

Mrs. Bodine shared an increased interest in Marine Technology and informed the group about supporting a grant application related to Marine Apprenticeships being applied for by CareerSource Florida and Florida Commerce.

3. Information on the status of existing talent pipelines for in-demand occupations.

Mrs. Bodine indicated that it is exciting to see the large numbers of graduates of all area post secondary educational institutions and applauded the efforts of all workforce partners for their contribution to the talent pipeline.

4. Miscellaneous

Tom P Haney Technical College- Angela Reese-Director

Angela Reese, Director of TPH Technical College reported that TPHTC will be changing their organizational chart with those in leadership roles being titled Assistant Director by area of expertise, and Heather Barton will be joining the Haney team as Assistant Director of Grants, Compliance, and Operational Services. At the end of April Haney students had achieved 291 industry certifications. She indicated that there will be approximately 200 students walking for graduation, however those earning a diploma/certificate are likely to be double that number. The stakeholder survey results indicated that the employability skills of Haney students have drastically improved; in direct correlation with programs mimicking workforce expectations. The COE annual report indicated that the majority of Haney students are under the age of 25, with almost a 50-50 split between male and female; still a struggle with non traditional student ratios, but that's the same with every technical college in the state. Classes at the East campus in Apalachicola begin August 4.

CTE Bay District Schools:

Jonathon Moore shared an update regarding CTE for BDS. Students were able to take field trips to EF San Juan where trusses and other construction components are built. Students got to see up close CNC machining and how it works. Mr. Moore himself was able to tour Ft. Walton Beach Machining where he was “blown away” by the type of work they do completing very meticulous parts needed for DOD projects. He made CTE instructors aware of the location and how it would benefit them to visit the site. He indicated that BDS was awarded \$8,075,000 in TRIUMPH Gulf Coast grants in 2024-25. He discussed Cape Funding stating that to date for the year, the cape funding had not yet been provided, however so far BDS had achieved 2400 credentials with 300 students left to test.
