Priority of Service means that covered persons are given precedence over non-covered persons to receive access to a service earlier in time than a non-covered person. If the resource is limited, the veteran or eligible spouse receives access to the service instead of or before the non-covered person.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Veteran—

A person who served at least one day in the active military, naval, or air service, and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable. Active service includes full-time Federal service in the National Guard or a Reserve component.

Eligible Spouse—

- A spouse of a veteran who died of a service-connected disability;
- A spouse of a member of the Armed Forces serving on active duty, at time of application for priority, is in one of these categories for more than 90 days:
 - Missing in action;
 - Captured in the line of duty by a hostile force;
 - Forcibly detained or interned in the line of duty by a foreign government or power;
- A spouse of any veteran who has a total disability resulting from a service-connected disability, as evaluated by Dept. of VA; or
- A spouse of any veteran who died while a total, service-connected disability was in existence.
