The Process

1. Create internship(s) description and learning plan
2. Complete Employer Intake Form
3. Provide CareerSource Gulf Coast with job titles and descriptions
4. Interview potential interns and complete vetting checklist
5. (Once an intern has been selected) Internship begins after final approval from intern's commander
